I am writing as a parent of (child's full name); a student currently enrolled in grade (grade number) at (school name). We greatly value the education our child receives at your institution and appreciate the school's commitment to its mission and independence as a private educational provider.

As you are aware, Texas Senate Bill 2 (89th Texas Legislature, 2025) established the Texas Education Freedom Accounts (TEFA) program, an education savings account initiative administered by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts. This program provides state funds to eligible families for certain approved education expenses, including private school tuition for participating students.

We have made the deliberate decision not to apply for or utilize any funds from the TEFA program (or any similar state-funded education savings account or voucher) for our child's education. Our child, (child's name), will continue to attend (school name) as a fully private-pay student, without any reliance on state-administered accounts or reimbursements.

We respectfully request that (school name) not submit any personally identifiable information, academic records, test results, demographic data, or other student-specific or family-specific information about our child or our household to the Texas Education Agency (TEA), the Comptroller's office, any certified educational assistance organization (CEAO), or any other state entity in connection with the TEFA program or Texas Senate Bill 2 requirements.

The reporting, testing, and data-sharing obligations under Texas Senate Bill 2 apply specifically to students participating in the program. Since our family has opted out entirely, no such reporting is required—or appropriate—for our child. We are concerned

that unnecessary submission of our child's data could compromise family privacy and our child's independence from state oversight and data collection.

Please confirm in writing, within 14 days of receiving this letter, that (School Name) will honor this request and refrain from transmitting our child's information to state entities under Texas Senate Bill 2 or related rules.

If the school believes any data submission is nonetheless mandated (even for non-participating students), please provide the specific statutory or regulatory citation requiring it, so we may review and address the matter accordingly.

We remain committed to our partnership with (School Name) and look forward to continuing our child's education in an environment free from unnecessary state involvement. Thank you for your attention to this important matter. I am available to discuss further if needed.
